Open to youth ages 9-13, **Potomac Whitewater Racing Team's** summer camp introduces recreational whitewater kayaking to kids in a low-key environment. To ensure high quality of instruction and the safety of our students, student to instructor ratio is 4:1. Our instructors are First Aid, CPR, and Swiftwater Rescue certified. The Potomac River, with its warm water, is the perfect place to take up the sport as a beginner. Beginners will learn safety skills and the fundamentals of maneuvering in easy current.
